League bowling begins the week of Sept 9, 2024

League bowling ends the week of Nov 18, 2024

Playoffs begin the week of Nov 4, 2024

Playoffs end the week of Nov 18, 2024

CONFERENCES

Each team bowls in a conference of 8 teams

Bowl against each team in your conference – 2 games = a ‘match’

One ‘match’ each week = 7 weeks of conference bowling

Conference Champions and ties receive ‘Champions Certificate’

PLAYOFFS

Top 16 teams and ties in each division based on total pins following 7 weeks of league bowling advance to the playoffs

Conference Champions advance to the playoffs if not in the top 16

The playoffs are a ‘one and done’ format – you win and you bowl on, you lose and your season is ended

WHO BOWLS The NSL Wii Bowl Championships are open to all Wii Bowlers – no age restrictions. Senior Wii bowlers are the core of our league. Bowlers with Intellectual and Developmental Differences are our second line of bowlers. The third line of bowlers --- anyone with 4 Wii Bowlers regardless of age or ability

Registration opens – Aug 1, 2024
Registration closes – Sept 4, 2024

REGISTRATION FEES \$250 for 1 to 4 teams
\$300 for 5 to 9 teams
\$400 for 10 to 14 teams
\$500 for 15+ teams

OF BOWLERS A team is 4 bowlers
A team may have 1 to 4 substitutes (8 roster bowlers maximum)
The NSL recommends 5 roster bowlers
All registered bowlers receive a ‘Certificate of Participation’

COACH Each team must have a dedicated Coach – generally the Activity Director in Senior Communities
The Coach may or may not be a Wii bowler
The Coach is responsible for posting weekly scores
The Coach is the ‘link’ between league management and the team(s)

POSTING SCORES Coaches post scores online using their email address and an assigned password
Scores must be posted on or before Friday – end of day – each week
Weekly Results and Standings are posted late Friday’s/Saturday AM

AWARDS

Champions in each division receive a NSL Etched Glass Award
'Finalist' in each division receive a NSL Etched Glass Award
NSL Wii Bowler of the Year receives an Award
NSL Coach of the Year receives an Award
All bowlers receive a 'Certificate of Participation'

GENERAL INFORMATION

Prior to the beginning of league bowling, the coach must assign his/her team(s) to a division based on team average. In order to determine which division your team(s) should be placed in, have each bowler roll a minimum of 4 games. Take the total pins of the bowler to find his/her average for the 4 games. Do the same for all the bowlers on your team(s). Then take the total pins of all the bowlers on your team(s) and divide by the number of bowlers. The figure will give you your team average and allow you to place your team in the proper division as shown above (see divisions).

The NSL produces two NSL Championships each year. One in the Spring (March/May) and one in the Fall (Sept/Nov).

Teams from outside the USA are invited to participate making for an International League for Wii Bowlers.

Any internet bowling game may be used. Nintendo Wii Sport package and Nintendo Switch are recommended. The Nintendo Wii Sport game can be found at most GAME STOP stores.

The NSL is a mission driven league sharing profits, if any, with dementia and Alzheimer programs.
